

(The following guide is made on an HTC Legend running Android 2.1)

Press the "menu" button on the phone and choose "Settings"

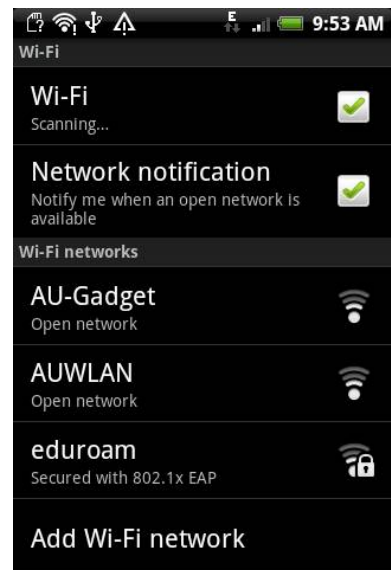
Choose "Wireless & networks"

Choose "Wi-Fi settings"



Choose the wifi network "eduroam" or choose "Add Wi-Fi network"

(If you choose "Add Wi-Fi network" you'll have to manually enter eduroam as the network name in the next step)



"EAP method" is set to "TTLS"

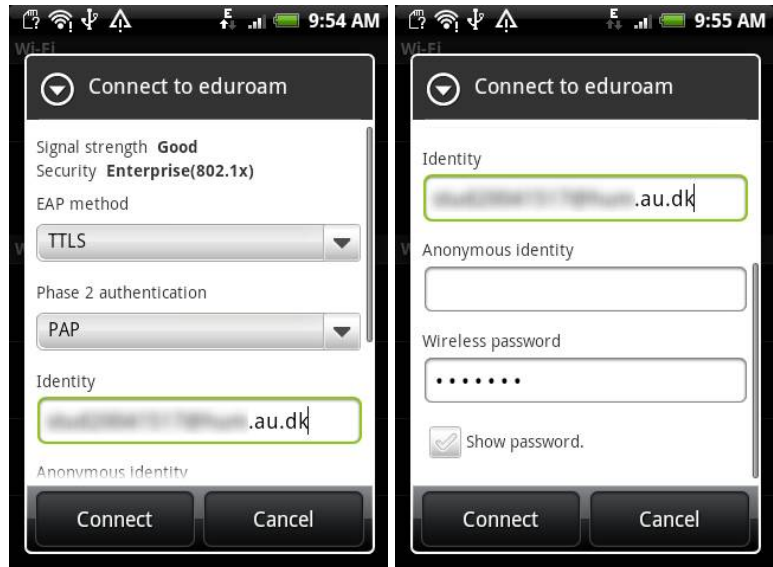
"Phase 2 authentication" is set to "PAP"

"Identity" is your personal username (see <http://eduroam.au.dk/en> )

"Anonymous identity" should be left blank

"Wireless password" is your personal password (see <http://eduroam.au.dk/en> )

Finish by pressing "Connect"



When configuration is done you should be connected to eduroam.

Choose "eduroam" again and you should receive a status dialog as shown. "IP address" should start with "10". Choose "Cancel" to close the dialog.
